

## Oscar Ticket Drawing Rules

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

### 1. Eligibility

Oscars 2015: Guess Who Will Win (“The Drawing”) is open to all students enrolled at Linganore High School in the Spring 2015 semester. The Drawing is subject to Frederick County Public Schools (“FCPS”) policies and regulations.

### 2. Sponsor

The Drawing is sponsored by Lancer Media, located at 12013 Old Annapolis Road, Frederick, Maryland 21701.

The Drawing is not endorsed by Linganore High School, FCPS, the Office of the Superintendent of Frederick County, or the Board of Education of Frederick County.

### 3. Agreement to Official Rules

Participation in The Drawing constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding. Winning a prize is contingent upon being compliant with these Official Rules and fulfilling all other requirements set forth herein.

### 4. Contest Period

The entry period for The Drawing begins on February 17, 2015 at 12:00 PM EST and ends on February 21, 2015 at 11:59 PM EST (“Contest Period”). Entries that are submitted before or after the Contest Period will be disqualified. Submissions will be accepted for the duration of the Contest Period using any of the following methods:

### 5. How to Enter

Online: This method of entry will be available by visiting our website ([LHSLance.org](http://LHSLance.org)) and following the directions provided to fill out the entry information, and submit.

Persons without internet access at home may enter The Drawing at Linganore High School during their regularly scheduled lunch shift. Those people may visit Lancer Media in room A206 (lunch shifts 1, 2, and 4) or C203 (lunch shift 3), to submit the online form.

Limit one (1) entry per person, per email address for the duration of the Contest Period, regardless of method of entry. Entries received from any person or email address in excess of the stated limitation will be void. All entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned.

**Entries that are incomplete, illegible, fraudulent or corrupted are void and will not be accepted.**

**6. Prize Drawing**

On or about February 25, 2015, the Sponsor will select potential winners from among all eligible entries received. Entries will be compared to the results from The 2015 Oscar Awards, and the number of correct guesses will be counted for each person. The entrant with the highest number of correct guesses will become The Winner. If there are multiple potential winners, The Sponsor will select one Winner in a random drawing. The Sponsor will attempt to notify the potential winner in person, via telephone, or by email on or about February 25, 2015. If the potential winner cannot be contacted within five (5) days after the date of the first attempt to contact him/her, the Sponsor may select an alternate potential winner in his/her place at random from the remaining non-winning, eligible entries.

**7. Winner Notification**

The potential winners will be notified in one or more than one of the following ways: in person, by email, mail, or phone. The Sponsor reserves the right to award the prize in the name of the winner's parent or legal guardian. Potential winners must continue to comply with all terms and conditions of the Official Rules, and winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements. In the event that a potential winner is disqualified for any reason, Sponsor will award the applicable prize to an alternate winner. Only three (3) alternate drawings will be held, after which the prize will remain un-awarded.

**8. Prizes**

One (1) Grand Prize includes two (2) coupon vouchers for Regal Entertainment Group Premiere Movie Tickets. Premiere tickets are valid for any movie, any day, any time at any Regal Cinemas, United Artists Theatres and Edwards Theatres nationwide and do not expire. The prize is subject to Regal Entertainment Group's terms and conditions and will be awarded "as-is."

**9. General Conditions**

In the event that the operation, administration, or security of the Drawing is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, virus, bug, worm, unauthorized human intervention or other technical problem, or in the event that the Drawing is unable to run as planned for any other reason, as determined by the Sponsor in its sole discretion, the Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, either (a) suspend the Drawing to address the impairment and then resume the Drawing in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules, or (b) terminate the Drawing, and, in the event of termination, award the prize at random from among the eligible, non-suspect entries received up to the time of impairment. The Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be

tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Drawing or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to damage the website or undermine the legitimate operation of the Drawing may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, the Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages (including attorneys fees) and any other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Failure by the Sponsor to enforce any provision of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

#### **10. Release and Limitations of Liability**

By participating in the Drawing, entrants agree to release and hold harmless the Sponsor, the Board of Education of Frederick County, MD, and each of their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies, other companies and organizations associated with the Drawing, and each of their respective officers, directors, employees, representatives, and agents (the Released Parties) from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of participation in the Drawing or receipt or use of the prize (including any travel or activity related thereto), including, but not limited to: (a) any technical errors associated with the Drawing, including lost, interrupted, or unavailable Internet Service Provider (ISP), network, server, wireless service provider, or other connections, availability or accessibility or miscommunications or failed computer, satellite, telephone, cellular tower or cable transmissions, lines, or technical failure or jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected transmissions or computer hardware or software malfunctions, failures or difficulties; (b) unauthorized human intervention in the Drawing; (c) mechanical, network, electronic, computer, human, printing or typographical errors; (d) application downloads, (e) any other errors or problems in connection with the Drawing, including, without limitation, errors that may occur in the administration of the Drawing, the announcement of the winner, the cancellation or postponement of the event and/or the flyover, if applicable, or the incorrect downloading of the application, or errors in the processing of entries application, downloads, or in any Drawing-related materials; or (f) injury, death, losses or damages of any kind, to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrant's participation in the Drawing or or acceptance, receipt, or misuse of the prize (including any travel or activity related thereto.) Except where prohibited, each entrant agrees that any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of, or connected with, the Drawing or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court located in Maryland. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation, and enforceability of these Official Rules, entrant's rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of the Sponsor in connection with the Drawing, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with the laws of Maryland, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules, which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than Maryland.

## **12. Winner Privacy**

The Sponsor may choose to disclose the name of the winner, with prior permission from the winner (and his/her parent or guardian, if the winner is under 18), at a time and through a medium of the Sponsor's choosing. The sponsor reserves the right to not disclose the winner's name if it so chooses.
